Curriculum

The college curriculum has been designed with the sole objective of providing excellence in education. The main subjects of study are English. maths, Science, Computer and Art with special attention on physical fitness, Music and Dance appreciation, Crafts, Manners and Etiquettes, etc.

Rules of the School

Enrollment of K.J. Modern School implies on the part of the pupil and parents willingness to comply with the requirement and regulations of the school.

- 1. Every year the registration for the admission to various classes opens in Feb.-March. The admission forms are available in Feb. the admission test is held in March & April.
- 2. Minimum age for admission to class 1st is 5 plus, at the beginning of session. For admission to nursery children aged minimum three years are preferred.
- 3. Application for admission should be made in writing on prescribed form. Application form and prospectus can be had from the school office on payment of prescribed fee. The application form must be accompanied by 2 passport sized photograph of the child.



- 4. The school reserves the right to grant or refuse admission to any child.
- 5. parents are required to submit the original Birth Certificate of their ward at the time of admission to class Ist., nursery or L. K.G. U.K.G. students may also submit photocopy of birth certificate along with the original birth certificate upon reaching class Ist.
- 6. Students who are under transfer from other schools have to produce Transfer certificate at the time of admission. those students who are under transfer from the outside U.P. must have their transfer certificate counter-signed by the inspector of schools of the state concerned.
- 7. Parents are required to give advance notice of at least of one month for the withdrawal of the wards otherwise one month's fees will be charged for issuing Transfer Certificate. A payment of is to be made for issue of transfer certificate.

Examination and Promotion

- 1. The examinations are held twice in a year in December and Aprilbesides to unit tests held in the months of September and January.
- 2. Cumulative assessment of the whole year's work is considered for grant of promotion to next higher class.
- 3. A student who fails twice in the same class will have to be withdrawn form the school.
- 4. In case of loss of report card, a duplicate will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/-



Payment of Fee

- 1. The fee can be paid in cash / by cheque / by POS machine at school office before 10th of the Fee month. The amount to be paid for every fee month is mentioned on the cover of the fee booklet. cheque should be drawn in the favour of "K J Modern Inter College" .The name and class of the students is to be mentioned at the back of the cheque.
- 2. If any reason the cheque bounces a fine of Rs 450/- plus late fees will be payable.
- 3. In case the fee is not paid by the 15th of fee month a fine of Rs. 25/-will be charged for payments made between 15th last day of month and Rs. 50/- for payments made during next month. If the fee remains unpaid for more than 50days the child's name will be struck off the school records without any further notice.
- 4. A re- admission fee of Rs.300/- will be charged in case of a child whose name has been struck off the rolls.

Conveyance

1. For The Convenience Of Children, School Rickshaws/van Are Available. The Charges For This Facility Are Not Included In The School Fee And Are To Be Paid For Separately. Once Engaged Rickshaw/van Charges Are Payably For The Whole Year. Rickshaw/van Charges Vary With Distance.



2. Although all efforts are made to make the rickshaw/van service regular, there are times when it becomes irregular due to unavoidable circumstances like sickness of Driver, etc. In such circumstances parents are required to cooperate with school authorities and ensure that the child reaches school in the morning in time. School will ensure their dropping back in the afternoon. Parents are reminded that despite our best efforts this may happen 3-4 times a month.

Medical and health

- 1. The school maintains records of its students' weight, height, inoculations, vaccinations, etc. and reminds the parents will in time if any action is due on the part of the parents.
- 2. The school organizes regular health checks of all children by well qualified doctors.
- 3. The services of a consulting doctor are always available to school children in case of an emergency.
- 4. The school maintains first-aid box and sick room facilities for any exigency.
- 5. The school gives extreme importance to the physical and mental fitness of children. parents are will advised to cooperate with that the school authorities in this regard.

Library

1. The school maintains a small but useful library on a



- variety of subjects and video cassettes.
- 2. The books can be borrowed by the students for a limited period against caution money.

Recommendations to parents
